

Title	“Dancing Puzzle”
Theme	Interculturality
Objectives	-to get closer with each other and to learn something about other cultures and by this loosing prejudices and stereotypes
Complexity (from 1 to 5)	4
Group size	36 (6 countries x 6 participants)
Participants	17 – 20
Duration	Full day
Overview activity (step by Step)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - making intercultural groups with participants - they invent the name of their group - they get the tape with a song (mix of songs which are typical for each country) –app. 1 min from each - regarding to this song they prepare their own choreography which has to includes folklore dance elements - they prepare costumes from sheets, scarf’s, hats etc - at the end each group will present the own choreography
Materials needed	Big place, music equipment, sheets, hats and scarf’s, scissors, staple, pens, etc.
Preparation before activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - participants can do games for the warming up, those games can be typical for their countries - before the activity each country presents their own traditional folklore dances
Instructions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - before the activity we make clear instructions how to form the mixed groups (from each country one participant) - give the name to the group - instructions about making choreography and making costumes - during the activity we are still reachable for consultations and any help
Debriefing and evaluation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - with one word express your feelings about the activity - what did you liked, what not - how it was communication in the group - how would you value your work in the group, are you satisfied with the final result - what did you learn about others/about other countries
Tips for facilitators	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - smaller group - instead of the international mixed song, they can use some funny song/song which they already know - without making costumes

Suggestions for follow up	They can do similar activity and instead of dancing they present games and fairytales (using theatre techniques) which are typical for different countries
Ideas for action	The gained knowledge, participants can use back home and teach/inform/share to the colleges ,schoolmates, friends etc.
