### Programme Description:

Art Interventions is an interdisciplinary programme that brings together local and international artists, scholars and decision makers to disadvantaged communities to rethink their current situation from historic, social, economic, political and cultural perspectives and offer new insights and innovative ways of conduct. The programme as a whole addresses European issues such as migration; commemoration as political identity building; interpersonal relations in time of transition. It works with various European, national and local institutions as well as civic and scientific networks.

The volunteering environment would consist of:

- NGO and organizational work
- Recurrent sensitive dealing with delicate social and intercultural relations
- Opportunities for semi-independent work on arts and social problems in transition countries
- Opportunities to travel

We can offer:

- Close work with and guidance by the programme/artistic manager in respect to NGO and cultural management skills. The volunteer will be gradually involved in conceptual and methodological planning of projects as well.
- Improvement of understanding and techniques related to problems arising during the implementation of projects.
- Contact to a diverse range of people in terms of age, gender, ethnicity, culture, belief, religion, education level, profession on a daily basis.
- Collaboration with a variety of academic fields, including anthropology, sociology and political science.
- Engagement with small local communities in urban and rural surroundings as well as on European and transnational level. The individual projects take place in small communities either in small towns and villages or in specific communities in bigger towns.
- Close acquaintance with the Balkan and its social-economic-political-cultural situation.

Formal arrangement:

The volunteership would be based on a cooperation between the network Citizens of Europe and the broadcasting company B92 in the framework of the Youth in Action programme of the European Commission (EVS).
